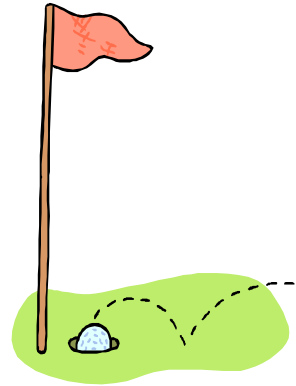


PINWILD MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

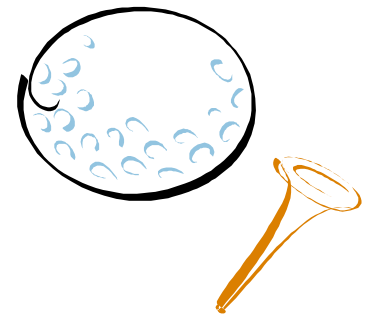
