We have a wonderful "mascot" for our Rally this year and you will see her around on posters and other places. She is really a "cute" OLD BAG!

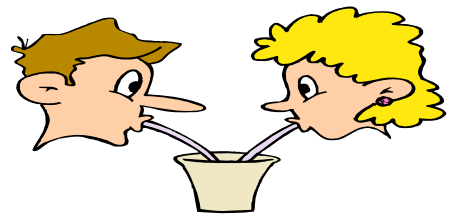
We will have the menu soon. We know it will be one of Chef Todd's delicious creations.
