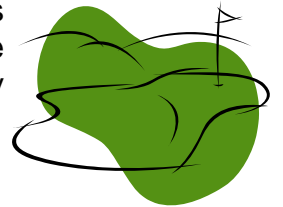


News from Golf Course Maintenance...

The aerification of the Bermuda Grass tees, fairways, “approaches” and roughs, which was completed during the month of June, went very well. During this time, some of the thinner areas were resodded [following loss of turf from “winter-kill”] and all the grass was fertilized. This aerification and fertilizer application will get the Bermuda grass growing nicely, with some quality playing surfaces expected for the rest of the summer and fall.

Despite the hot weather, the Bent Grass greens are doing well with some healthy turf. As you may know, this hot summer weather creates much stress on the greens. The maintenance staff will continue to “run hard” this summer, checking greens. The staff will be checking greens in the AM, as well as after lunch. With the stress that the bent grass will be under, time is more than often “of the essence”, and it is important that the staff be allowed the time they need to accomplish the task of watering or cooling-down the greens.
