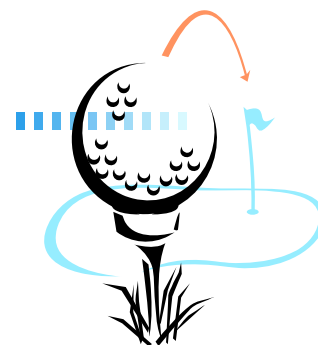

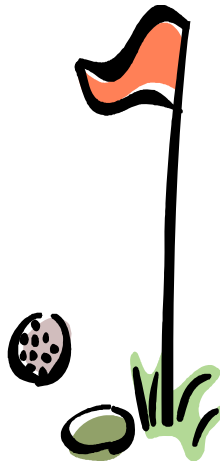

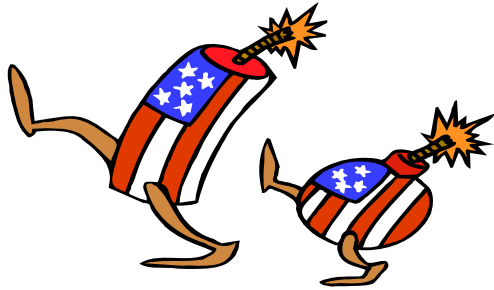

**The Maintenance Staff** is once again requesting that the membership cooperate with the folks who will be “running hard” this summer checking greens. The staff will be checking greens in the AM, as well as after lunch. With the stress that the bent grass will be under, time is more than often “of the essence”, and it is important that the staff be allowed the time they need to accomplish the task of watering the green. We will ensure that the staff stays out of the way as much as possible and is courteous, but at times, they may be in the way of play.

In June we will be closing 9 holes of golf from Monday through Thursday...this to completely aerate the all Bermuda fairways, tees and roughs. During this time, we will operate with a 27-hole split-tee rotation...excluding the 9 holes that is being aerated and playing a combination of possibly the Holly & Magnolia. More details will be available on the day of check-in as to what the “rotation to be played” will be. When posting your score for handicap purposes, this can be done as posting 2 9-hole scores if one did not play the entire Holly or Magnolia.
