The Closing luncheon for the 2017 PWGA season was held on December 5th. The meeting was called to order by President Lydia Healy at 11:20 AM. Lydia announced that the 2017 Board members had updated the standing rules, now posted on the PWGA website. All forty of the PWGA volunteers were thanked for their hard work this year, especially Madeline Barry (publicity) and Mary Schneider (website).

The 2017 Board members were introduced: Lydia Healy, Bobbi Erdman, Jan Behnke, Mary Jane Crabill, Joan Power, Paula Fitzgerald, Helen Simms, Paula Montgomery, Chris Johnson, Rita Danker, Jody Young and Barbara Vincenti. Treasurer Jan Behnke had a final printed budget on each table. Dues for 2018 will be the same as 2017. Collection began on December 5th and will continue until January 31st. (Dues \$50, optional Chip-in-Club \$5.00 and Hole-in-One Club \$10).

Pinewild earned two special First Place Awards this year. First Place in Pinetops and First Place win for Interclub One, last won by Pinewild in 2007. Interclub Two came in second in the League.

Handicap Chairperson Marcia Krasicky mentioned that 88.7% of players posted correctly this year, a 4.7% increase from 2016. Lydia Healy reported that there were 56 chip-ins each with value of \$6.43. Birdie Chairperson Jean Brobst showed that 66 members had a total of 186 birdies. Paula Fitzpatrick had the most birdies (15) with Jean Grieshaber a close second place (14). Holes and number of birdies...Magnolia holes 5, 6, 7, 8 each had 3 birdies. Holly Holes were #3 (21), #5 (19), #8 (10), #12 (19), #14 (23), and #17 (28). Ringer Chairperson Shirley Wake shared that the Ringer Winners (5 points each) were Nancy Butler, Paula Fitzpatrick, Deb Chuderewicz, Helen Simms, Freddy Mastandrea. Louise Pryor tied with Jean Weiler and Judy Smith.

Tournament Directors Paula Fitzpatrick and Helen Simms were praised for their innovations for our Tuesday Play-days, Skins Game, Wrong Side of the Tracks Event, the Shootout and Halloween Spectacular! There were 2,095 event points awarded this year (\$2.50 per point). Total Point winner was Jean Grieshaber (55). April Zelinski was Most Improved Player going from a 16.8 handicap in April to a 13.7 handicap. Helen Simms was the NC State Play Day winner (net 69), the Shootout Winner was Denise Petricola (worth Dues for 2018). There were three Holes-in-One for 2017...Deb Chuderewicz [Magnolia 3], Denise Petricola [Magnolia 7] and Diane Dunlap [Holly 8].

Our tradition of collecting food for the Sandhills Food Bank resulted in 685 pounds of donations. For the year, 2017 PMGA members donated a total of over \$6,000 to the NC Girls Junior Golf Program, Boys and Girls Club of Sandhills and First Health Cancer Care.

The PWGA membership applauded Gayle Welter who is now retiring after 21 years in the PWGA.

One By-Law Amendment was unanimously approved by the membership stating that the Vice-President will post the PWGA membership lists on the Website.

Nominating Chairperson Barbara Vicenti presented the 2018 Slate of Officers...Sally Manich, Vice President/President Elect...Treasurer, Shirley Wake...Social Chair, Judy Smith...Tournaments Directors Elect, Pat Marki and Kathy McGushin. The membership approved the nominations with one nay vote.

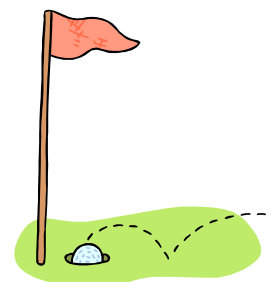
