Program will include focusing on – Introduction to the game, Full Swing Instruction, Putting/ Chipping/Pitching/Bunker Play Instruction, Golf Course Etiquette, Empowerment Speech, Contests, On-Course Play, Rules of Golf and much more. Students should assemble at the Bag Drop area at the Clubhouse five minutes prior to the session starting. While some Clubs could be available for use if prior arrangements are made... **participants will need to bring their own clubs.**

Upon **successful** completion of the program, each student will receive a “Junior Players Pass” to play on Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst’s **Azalea Course** at no charge. (Some restrictions will apply)

Camp Objective:

“To introduce area youngsters to the game of golf, and provide them with the skills necessary to play and enjoy the game of a lifetime. This instruction will cater to young golfers of ALL SKILL LEVELS, and will include set-up fundamentals, full swing and short game, as well as the etiquette and the rules of the game. Emphasis will also be placed on empowering young people to apply the integral components that the game demands (honesty, determination, patience, dedication, concentration, and good sportsmanship) to a real life setting away from the golf course.”

Instructors:

PGA Members and Apprentices from The Pinewild Golf Academy will provide instruction.

Class Size:

Minimum 8 students – Maximum 30 students per session.

Age Groups:

Youth Ages 8 - 16

Cost:

The cost per session is \$85.00 per person (a session is three consecutive mornings – Monday through Wednesday)

Registration:

Registration form and payment **must be received by the Wednesday prior to the first day** of the session.

Dress:

All participants should dress in accordance with the Pinewild dress code regulations during all days of sessions. Blue jeans, short shorts, tee shirts, and tank tops are not proper golf attire. **Boys must wear shirts with a collar, and all juniors should have their shirts tucked in. Hats, if worn, should be worn with the brow facing forward.**
