Pinetop: Karen Teems announced that the first Pinetop event will be on April 20 at Pinehurst #5. One important change this year: At the conclusion of play, check the four-person scorecard, then hand in to the scoring table. We are playing for points. Once you sign up on *Golf Genius*, be sure to let Nancy Wurst or Karen Teems know as soon as possible if you have to cancel.

Tar Heel: Louise Pryor announced that there are 14 member clubs from Raleigh to Wilmington participating. Prestonwood has been added! Sandy Dickinson is this year's President. Each club hosts once every 2 years. Handicap max is 32.9. Each club may field seven players, plus more if there's room. Tees are "red" and "forward". One month before each tournament, we will get the invitation from the host club. Sign up in *Golf Genius*. Individual Accounts will be billed.

Holly Challenge: Cathy Slocum announced that sign-ups open today on *Golf Genius*. Format is a two-day two best balls of foursome.

Interclub I: Tami Ostroski thanked last year's Interclub captains, especially April Zelinski for serving again this year. Info and signups are under the PWGA portal under special events. There will be 16 players fielded for each match, plus subs. First match is on Pinehurst #9 on May 9. Players must have posted 8 rounds of golf at their home club by May 2, one week prior to the first match. Interclub I requires that players must post 2 rounds between matches, including one at home. This is not a requirement to play on Interclub II, but keep this in mind if your handicap is on the bubble. We will keep last year's navy shirt if you have it, or any navy shirt, and coordinate your bottom color with your partner.

Ringers - Cathy Slocum: If a member changes her tee selection on May 1, her ringers will restart on May 1.

Golf Fore Africa: Donna Rotondo announced there will be an event at CCNC on June 1, with LPGA pros holding a clinic followed by a cocktail reception. This

charity, headed by Betsey King, provides life-giving water for people in Africa. A \$50 donation provides water for one individual for a lifetime.

Think Pink: Jean Brobst announced that June 7 will be our fundraiser for a local breast cancer support group.

Club-Sponsored Member/Guest: Now known as the "Diamond Invitational", this annual tournament will be sponsored by the Golf Shop and held on October 4, 5 and 6. Membership in the PWGA is not required, but you must have a PCC golf membership. You may invite up to 3 guests.

Comments by Allan Trepczyk: Every Tuesday we ask that each foursome turn in one master scorecard plus a duplicate. All scores will be posted by the Golf Shop. Golf Genius will be used each week. Monday noon closes the signup for the following day's game. Email with pairings and hole assignments will be issued later on Monday.
