

Please remember, an acceptable pace of play at Pinewild is 4 hours and 15 minutes for 18 Holes. For the enjoyment of all golfers, we respectfully request that you follow the guidelines below.

~ KEEP COURSES IN BEST PLAYABLE CONDITION ~

- PLEASE Observe and Obey all golf cart rules and signs
 - o This includes ENTERING the course at 90° from the Cart Path to where your ball is located
 - Minimizing cart traffic on the grass areas, and EXITING the hole to the cart path when one reaches the YELLOW rope across the fairway
 - o "Cart Path Only" means all four wheels remain on cart path
 - o Courteously follow the instructions of the course Starter, Rangers and Staff.
- Properly rake bunkers and place rakes outside of bunkers where it does not obstruct play
- Fill Divots, we ask that you fill your divot with sand provided, along with filling one other divot
- PLEASE remember to take the Sand Bottle to the Par 3 Tee, or with you when it is Cart Path Only
- Sand Bottles can be filled at the Restrooms OR at the first and tenth tees
- Dragging Your Feet, do not twist or drag shoes on greens, even with soft spikes
- Ball Marks, correctly repair your ball mark and at least one other
 - o This means "pulling in" the sides of the ball mark, as opposed to "pulling up" the roots.
- After putting, tap down spike marks especially near the cup
- When removing the flagstick, "rotate it" upon removal, so the cup does not get "pulled up"
- Ensure flagsticks are returned completely to the bottom of cup
- Dispose of trash appropriately (including cigarette and cigar butts)
- To reduce unnecessary wear and tear on the courses, please ensure that ALL golfer's pair-up as it relates to riding in carts. This as opposed to utilizing "single rider" carts.

~ ADHERE TO ALL LOCAL RULES ~

- Out of Bounds- defined by grey stakes with a white top, the wooden fence on holes 4 and 5 of the Holly and the inside edge, and beyond, of all public asphalt paved roads.
- Yardage bushes- located on both sides of fairways indicating 150 yards are integral parts of the course, therefore No Relief.
- No Entry or No Play- from all Environmentally Sensitive Areas and/or Private Yards.
- Sandy Waste Areas- identified with green stakes are not Bunkers.
- Local Drop Areas [hole 12 & 16 on Holly]- located "over" the Penalty Area and identified by a Black Stake.
- All Paved Cart Paths, along with all associated path curbing are Obstructions.
- Green-Side Sprinkler Heads, in closely mown area are Immovable Obstructions.
