- Boys & Girls Club 25th Anniversary Golf Event - Linda Schneiter asked for PWGA e-mail and monetary support of this event on June 21. Since the club has already sent out information to all members via Pinewild eNews, the PWGA Board decided not to take any further action.
- PALS/PWGA fun 9-hole event - Since this is a popular event, there was discussion that for next year's event we may want to think about adding both front and back play to accommodate 96 people.
