THE PINEWILD MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION HOLE-IN-ONE CLUB

The PMGA facilitates a hole-in-one (HIO) club for its members. All PMGA members are welcome to join by contributing \$20 to the hole-in-one "prize pool." Pinewild Country Club (PWCC) will bill each prior year's member's account in January for the HIO Club fee for the upcoming year, unless the prior year member opt-outs of the HIO Club via email. New members may join anytime, but to be eligible for an award, membership in the club must be documented at least one day prior to scoring a hole in one. The membership is documented when the PMGA Treasurer has received the member's check. The Hole-in-One Club runs from January 1st to December 31st each year. You will not qualify for a Hole-in-One payout during the year unless you have previously joined the Hole-in-One club for the year.

A cash award of \$100 will be made when the "ACE" is reported. At the end of the year, each person scoring a hole-in-one will also receive an engraved bag tag denoting the event. The residual "pot" will be distributed after the end of the calendar year to the members who have scored a hole in one that year. The amount will be proportional depending how many members join the club and number of Aces scored.

Hole-in-One Requirements:

- A) During a sanctioned PMGA event, a Hole-in-One is valid from any official tee box (Black, Blue, White, Gold, Red, or Green) for that event on the Magnolia, Holly, or Azalea (sanctioned PMGA event only).
- B) During other play at Pinewild on the Magnolia or Holly only, the Hole-in-One is valid from the Black, Blue, White, Gold, Red, or Green tees.

NOTE: In both A and B above: You must play a minimum of 9 holes and the ace must be witnessed by two additional golfers.

NOTE: If a PMGA sanctioned event is being played as a two-some (e.g., The Holly Challenge or Ryder Cup), a Hole-in-One is considered valid when witnessed by your playing partner(s).

C) You must place a signed scorecard attested to by all witnesses into the PMGA drop box in the men's locker room. Please also include the club used, yardage, and number of career aces.
