

Holly Challenge

Entries Open:	Signup for the tournament will be online mid-February till late-March. No entries will be accepted after the announced closing date.
Registration:	Open to all PMGA members.
Entry Fee:	\$20 per player.
Field:	Flights will be determined based on number of participants playing from the Blue, White, Gold, Red, or Green tees.
Field Limit:	There is no limit.
Format:	An extended, handicapped Match Play tournament held on the Holly Course. Players will be placed in flights. Each player will be responsible for arranging his own match with his opponent for each round. Ladder formatted pairing sheets will be kept up to date and posted in the locker room. Based on signups per division, a qualifying round may be required and the matches will be based on player indexes. Players are encouraged to play their match on PMGA days when the PMGA plays the Holly Course. On those days notify the pro shop that you will be playing your Holly Challenge match and you will not be placed in the PMGA weekly game. Each match must be played within each period. Ample time has been allowed for the matches to be played. However, if the players cannot come to an agreement on a date of play and neither player can play when the other wants to, the player who can play the final day of a round, gets a tee time and reports to the pro shop to play, is declared the winner. If neither player shows up to play the match, both forfeit. In extreme circumstances where a match cannot be played in the defined time period, the Chairman of the tournament will make the decision on any extension.
Course:	Holly exclusively.
Dates for each round:	Begins in April. Other dates will be determined.
Tees:	Players play the tees based on the PMGA Tee Policy as of January 1 of the current year.
Flights:	The number of flights will be based on the number of players in each division. Your flight placement will be based on your April 1st index.
Handicaps:	Strokes during actual match play within each flight will be based on the current USGA index. Net stroke play will be off the low handicap competitor. Competitors are responsible for verifying participant's handicaps. Handicap holes are played as defined on the card even if you start on the back nine.
Prizes:	Prize money is divided by each division and will be awarded at the PMGA Closer to each flight Champion and possibly others based on the number of participants. The names of the flight winners will be engraved on the permanent plaque kept in the locker room.
Posting:	Report the results of each match by noting the date and result of the match on the tournament pairing sheet posted in the locker room (example John Public, 4/22, 3 and 2). If a match is not played, or a player forfeits a match by the end of the allotted time, the forfeiting players will be eliminated and the next opponent will receive a bye for the next match. Post score as a Home score. For conceded putts



	and unfinished holes use “most likely score” according to Rule 3 of the World Handicap System effective January 2020.
