PMGA Lottery Rules

The PMGA facilitates a lottery as an additional incentive for members to participate in weekly events. A lottery is not conducted during significant PMGA events.

- 1. Each PMGA member is assigned a number at the beginning of the year or when they join mid-term.
- 2. When registering for a play day online through Golf Genius, the member will automatically be enrolled in the Lottery. A One Dollar (\$1.00) fee will be billed to the member's club account in addition to the Five Dollar (\$5.00) play day fee for that play day.
- 3. After the round is played for the day, an Executive Board Member will randomly draw a number from the total membership number pool.
- 4. That drawn number will be checked to see if that member played that day.
- 5. If the number drawn matches a member who played, that member is the winner of Fifty Percent (50%) of the entire pot.
- 6. If the number drawn is a member who did not play, the pot for the day rolls on to the next drawing.
- 7. A message will be sent to all PMGA members informing the results of the day. The message will include how much the lottery is/was worth and if we had a winner or not.

Eventually someone will win but ONLY if you play!
