Finally, some more consistent Spring weather has arrived, and this is truly a great time to be in the Sandhills of North Carlina.

In March we hosted the season openers for the various Golf Associations, as well as the first "two-day" golf event of the year. These events were very well attended...THANKS to the Membership for their support. As many of our Members start to work on their golf games with the onset of the warmer weather, don't forget our PGA Staff stands to help you with all aspects of your game, as well as equipment needs. Gus at the Academy, as well as Kyle, Allan and Rob have what you need to play your BEST golf.

As the weather and the soil temperatures have started to "warm-up", we have started seeing the Bermuda grass "wake-up". Soil samples have been taken on all the greens, and some fairways as needed. This will help correct any soil deficiencies needed as we transition from Spring to Summer. All greens will be fertilized in the coming weeks to promote early growth and help to heal any thin spots following the Winter months. Sand continues to be added to numerous greenside bunkers, and this will continue until all greenside bunkers are complete. This will include repairing any drainage, as needed, before adding the sand. The second application of pre-emergent herbicide, and fertilizer, is scheduled for the week of April the 8th. This fertilizer will help to grow the Bermuda grass and get the grass ready for the Summer when, additional fertilizations will take place.
