## E. DRIVING RANGE UTILIZATION

All Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst practice facilities are for members and registered guest only. The practice facilities which include the putting green, chipping green, academy area, and driving range are not open for general public or Pinewild Community usage.

The Club utilizes three practice tee areas throughout the year. The tee area on the front part of the driving range is referred to as the "Upper Tee" and "Lower Tee". The tee area located at the rear left of the driving range adjacent to the Academy is referred to as the "Wedge Tee", and the tee area located at back of the range is referred to as the "Challenge Tee" and is reserved for the Pinewild Country Club Golf Academy and private lessons only. In the event the upper tee is utilized for a tournament, the "Challenge Tee" will be made available for members to use.

**Hours of Operation:** Monday – Sunday 7:00am – 8:00pm (*Hours subject to vary due to season and first scheduled tee time*)  
*Thursday- Driving range will close following the last PMGA tee time until 2:30pm –3:00pm for range maintenance.*

## G. MEMBER TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

Full Members are encouraged to make tee times nine (9) days in advance. Tee times may be made in the following manner:

- **Web Reservation System:** Full Members may book starting at 8:30p.m., nine (9) days in advance by accessing Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst's Web Reservation System. To utilize the web reservation system, please see a member of Professional Staff to ensure all the criteria for member access has been obtained prior to booking. For instructions to book online, please see section- K. Club Webpage & Member's Web Reservation.
- **Telephone/ In-Person:** Members may reserve tee times in advance by contacting the Golf Shop via telephone or in-person. Full Members are permitted eight (8) days in advance and Club Members (previously referred to as Social/Tennis) may seven (7) days in advance. The member may start calling for advanced tee times starting at 7:45am January, February, November and December, 7:15am March through October.

**Members are limited to one tee time prior to 10:30am, but may reserve two tee times per person after 10:30am.** It is the responsibility of the member reserving the tee time, accurately to provide all the names of the fellow members who will be accompanying him or her in the respective group. ## H. CLUB HANDICAP

Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst uses the GHIN System to administer member handicaps. All resident members are required to keep a current handicap at Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst. A club handicap is mandatory for members who wish to participate in PMGA or PWGA. A member may obtain a GHIN number for posting scores, or may transfer their handicap from an existing club by seeing a member of our Professional Staff. The member's annual handicap fee of \$40.00 (per member) will be billed to the respective account. The fee will provide members the access to post scores in multiple locations: club posting stations, via internet either through [www.pinewildcc.com](http://www.pinewildcc.com), [www.ghin.com](http://www.ghin.com), or by downloading the GHIN app on your personal cell phone.

## I. CLUB TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst is an active club with numerous member tournaments. If a member wishes to sign-up for an event, the event will open for electronic entry three (3) weeks prior to the event. If the event has food & beverage or dining associated with the tournament, we ask that the member indicate whether or not you will be

attending, along with any non-playing spouses or significant others joining. This will allow the Chef and Staff to properly prepare for the event ensuring a smooth and enjoyable event for all. The Club has a strict forty-eight (48) hour Cancellation policy. A member that cancels within forty-eight (48) hours of the start of the tournament will be accountable for all charges incurred with respect to Entry Fees and/or Food & Beverage charges.

If you must cancel from an event, or anticipate the need to cancel, that you do so as far in advance as possible. This will allow the Professional Staff to find a replacement to maintain a level and competitive playing field.

**L. CART PLANS, LEASES AND TRAIL FEES.**

Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst offers a variety of cart options for those members wishing to either use a club cart, or purchase a private cart. Many members prefer private carts because of the various benefits associated with it. The following is a list of different options that the Club provides:

- Pay As You Go – Individuals may use a club cart and pay \$19.00 (including tax) per person each time they play an 18-hole round.
- Cart Lease – Allows members the opportunity to use a club cart, but not have to pay each time they decide to play a round of golf. The cart lease allows an individual to play an unlimited number of rounds in a calendar year. The cart lease fee annually per individual is \$ 1,250.00 (plus tax) per year. This plan is billed to respective members accounts quarterly.
- Trail Fee – Single/Family– For those Full Members who wish to have their own cart, and choose not to pay a fee for each use. A fixed yearly trail fee of \$1,250.00 for an individual, or \$1,750.00 per couple. This trail fee will be billed two times over the course of the year.

- Daily Trail Fee (\$12.75) – For those Full Members who wish to have their own cart, but choose to pay as they go. This plan has no trail fee, but the individual(s) will be charged \$12.75 each time they play a round of golf. There is a nine-hole rate available for those individuals who wish not to play 18 holes.

Please see the Private Cart Agreement and the Cart Lease Agreement before purchasing a private cart. These documents outline all current restrictions and qualifications of the private cart or club cart lease.

**Trolley** – A Trolley is a three-wheeled push-pull cart used when a player walks to help “caddie” their clubs during a round of golf. Members may rent for 9-holes at \$5.00 or 18-Holes \$10.00. Members enrolled in an Unlimited Trail Fee may use the trolley at no charge as an extension of their agreement. Trolleys are used on a first-come-first-serve basis.

#### N. GOLF INFORMATION AND ETIQUETTE

The membership of Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst is conscious of their “pace of play”, and for that reason, it is important to discuss some of our guidelines. Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst maintains a strict desire to adhere to a four hour and fifteen-minute round of golf. Although the Club employs Player Assistants to help with pace of play, **pace of play is the player's responsibility.** Therefore, the club will respectfully request that all members be aware of their pace as well as position on the golf course(s) at all times.

Any member or guest that has been warned more than once about a pace of play issue will be asked to skip to the position in which they should be on the course at that time. This will help alleviate a backup on the golf course,

making the playing experience more enjoyable for all golfers. Course condition is also a concern of the membership. We ask that all players do the following:

- Please repair your ball mark on the greens. If your ball is in the back of the green, please make sure to check the front of the green, invariably your ball left a pitch mark. Please survey the green for your ball mark, and repair any ball marks you may find in the process.
- Sand your divots in the fairways. Do not replace the divot, but rather fill the divot with the sand mix located on the side of the cart. This will give the divot a faster chance to heal more effectively.
- Rake the bunkers after your play a shot from them. When you are finished, please replace the rake to the outside of the bunker.
- Please make sure to discard cigarette butts in trash containers or keep them in the cart during your round. Please also discard any trash in trash containers or in your cart until the round is over.
