


Below are the adjustments made for the Schedule:

- The Crystal Invitational- The event has returned to the fall.
- **Registration** If a format requires a foursome, members must register as a foursome in order to compete. It should not be the Club responsibility to find, or provide players for the team to compete.
 - Looking for a Team? If a single member or couple wish to register, they may contact the Golf Shop to have their name placed on a list visible on the Event Portal. This will afford those trying to form a team resource for another player.

By implementing this system, it will eliminate the issue of pairing members together who do not wish to play together. In addition, it will eliminate for the Club to provide a player to compete.

Guest information, if a member enters a generic number, ie. 12345 their registration may be revoked.

Active Established GHIN Handicap

This is a requirement as members are paying entry fee and winning earnings distributed in the form of Golf Shop Credit.

• **Option 2-** All participants must have an Active Established GHIN Handicap to register for a Club Event, if a player does not have an established handicap, they will play to a 0.

This will also pertain to members who do not have an established handicap (ie. PAL, New Members).

Handicap Error or Tee Assignments

Tee Assignments and Handicap Analysis will be provided before each event. It is the members responsibility to inform the Golf Shop if an error is noticed by replying the initial email. The adjustment of an index will directly affect the Flight Assignments. Tee assignments can affect the flight assignment, other factors to consider.

• **Substitutions**- If a team has a player drop, the team has the following options: Play as a threesome, or Withdraw from the event. Last-minute substitutions are <u>Not</u> <u>Permitted</u> once pairings and flights have been established and released to the field.

COMMITTEE AUTHORITY



TOURNAMENT TEE SELECTION POLICY

Members may select their preferred tee per club event. On events that cover multiple days, the selection must be used for both courses. Tee selection must be identified by closing date of the entries for the event.

POSTING EVENT SCORES

Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst Handicap Committee and Club Management has instituted that all the Club Events listed above will be posted by the Golf Shop. The Event Information Sheet defines whether the round is "Non-Posting, Posting, and or "Competition Round" as in accordance to the USGA Compliance. All posted scores will be subject to appropriate equitable Stroke Control. Any and all scores from the event posted by participants, or in error, will be immediately removed by the Golf Shop. All Posted Club Events will be utilized by the Committee for official club audits.




